God Still Speaks! December 2020

"Jesus was praying ... The disciples found him, 'Everyone is looking for you!'" Mark 1:35

This Advent/Christmas is a special celebration, we are using a unifying theme. Each Sunday there will be variations on, "*If God is still speaking, what is God saying?*". Gracie Allen wrote in her last letter to George Burns before her death, "*Never place a period where God has placed a comma*". It suggests we never give up hope because God never gives up on us, so we need to continue living a joyous, full life. Our "*God is Still Speaking*" themes for Advent/Christmas are:

Sunday, November 29<sup>th</sup>, 1<sup>st</sup> Advent, "God Speaks with Assurance" Sunday, December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> Advent, "God Speaks with Tenderness" - Communion Sunday, December 13<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Advent, "God Speaks with Certainty" Sunday, December 20<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> Advent, "God Speaks in Wonder" Thursday, December 24<sup>th</sup> - Christmas Eve, "God Speaks in Light" Christmas Day - "God Speaks Through Us"


The Pilgrim Father, *Reverend John Robinson*, said, "*There is yet more light to shine forth from God's Word*", i.e. the Bible continues to speak its revelations to anyone who faithfully reads and reflects on it. A big thank you to all who have kept up with their pledges and plate donations. This is extremely helpful, so that the church can cover its expenses. This allows our church to continue with the online worship services and continue serving the community through the Dinner Bell and the Food Pantry.

All members should have received a Stewardship letter with a 2021 pledge card. If you did not receive one, please call the church. Please be sure to mail your pledge card back to the church as soon as possible, so the trustees can update the 2021 budget with the total pledged.

The trustees met with the architect, and Bergeron Technical Services to review the priorities for the master plan and approve the next stage. The next steps will be to have structural designs and plans drawn.

Building use protocols have been set and have been posted around the church. We had hoped to have the self-help groups back in the church by December 1st, but that is now on hold due to the increase in Corona virus cases in Carroll County.




