We waited all spring for this warm summer weather....and now it is August.

On July 17th we had a Special Meeting to give an update on the mid-year financials. Thank you to all who stayed at the church and on-line. For those who did not attend, we gave an update comparing the 2022 budget to actual numbers. The areas that were higher than budgeted were the oil and plowing costs to the church and for the Parsonage. We had increased costs for oil and repairs (stove and hot water heater). The extra costs totaled




distanced from others just let the usher of the day know. We will be happy to seat you in an area away from others."




