Trustee's & Flood Update

Spring is here, but with a couple of feet of new snow on the ground. As a result of the storm, we were unable to have the Palm Sunday Service. It is always a tough call, especially since John, the Diaconate and Web team put so much time into preparing the services.

In March, the Trustees and Council continued discussing flood repairs. The crawlspace work is not done yet, the replacement of the soil is still to be done. The oil smell is still there. Cleaning out the food pantry and other parts of the church is ongoing; hard to do when it is cold inside. An application has been filed with FEMA, but it is a reimbursement program, so funds are not received until after repairs are completed.

Please mark your calendars and plan to attend the **Special Meeting on April 21st.** The worship **service will start at 9:30**, and the meeting will follow immediately after the service. At the Annual Meeting, you were all given a list of 6 options and a survey to return. We received 13 surveys back. Each of the 6 options have been looked into and we will provide the findings to you. A packet of information will be mailed to all members for you to review prior to the meeting.

This meeting is important, and your feedback is needed. Once an option is decided on, the Council can move forward in planning the next steps.

Ideally, as warmer weather comes, we hope to get the Food Pantry and Dinner Bell back up and running. Funds will need to be raised to get the water and plumbing work done, install a hot water heater and connect a propane tank.

We have some fundraising events that are still in the planning stages. These help get the word out to the community about the flood and help raise funds for the repairs.

- The first one is at the American Legion, a Fish Fry on April 19th from 4-7:00pm; this one is set.
- The second one is on June 9th at the Tuckerman Brewery 3-6pm with the Blue Grit Blues Band, still working out details.
- The next one is a joint yard sale with the Conway Historical Society on July 13th.

We are not having the Spring Event this year, so we hope to have more along with the yard sale as we have done in the past at the Spring event. Lastly, is the Fryeburg Fair which is a "must do". We are working on what needs to be done to the building to make that happen.




